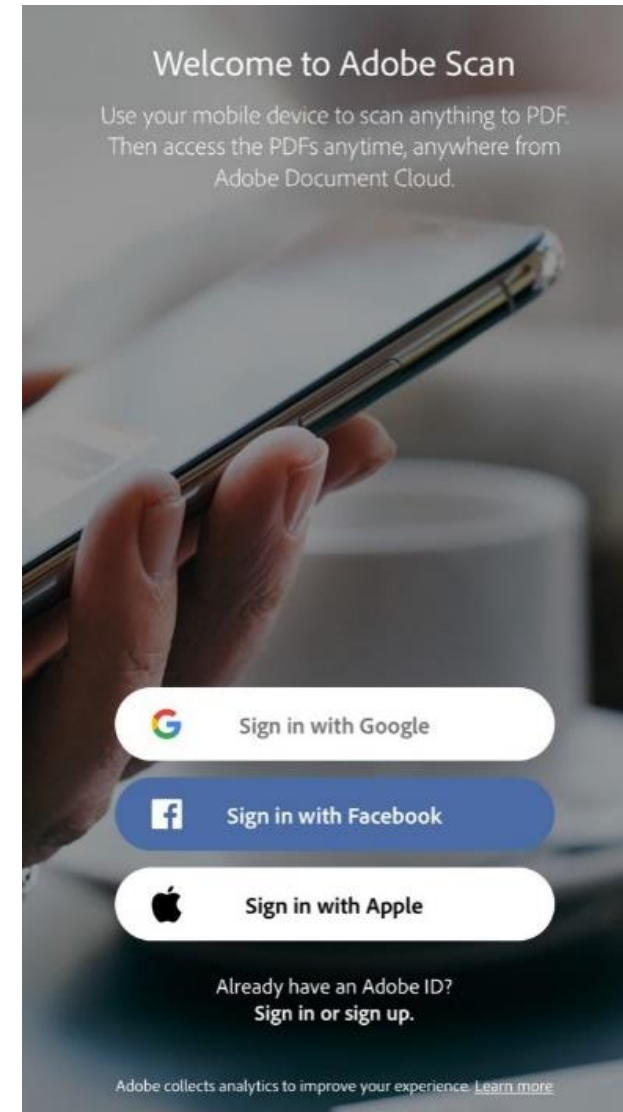

If you **HOLD** an unrestricted FAA ATP: ?

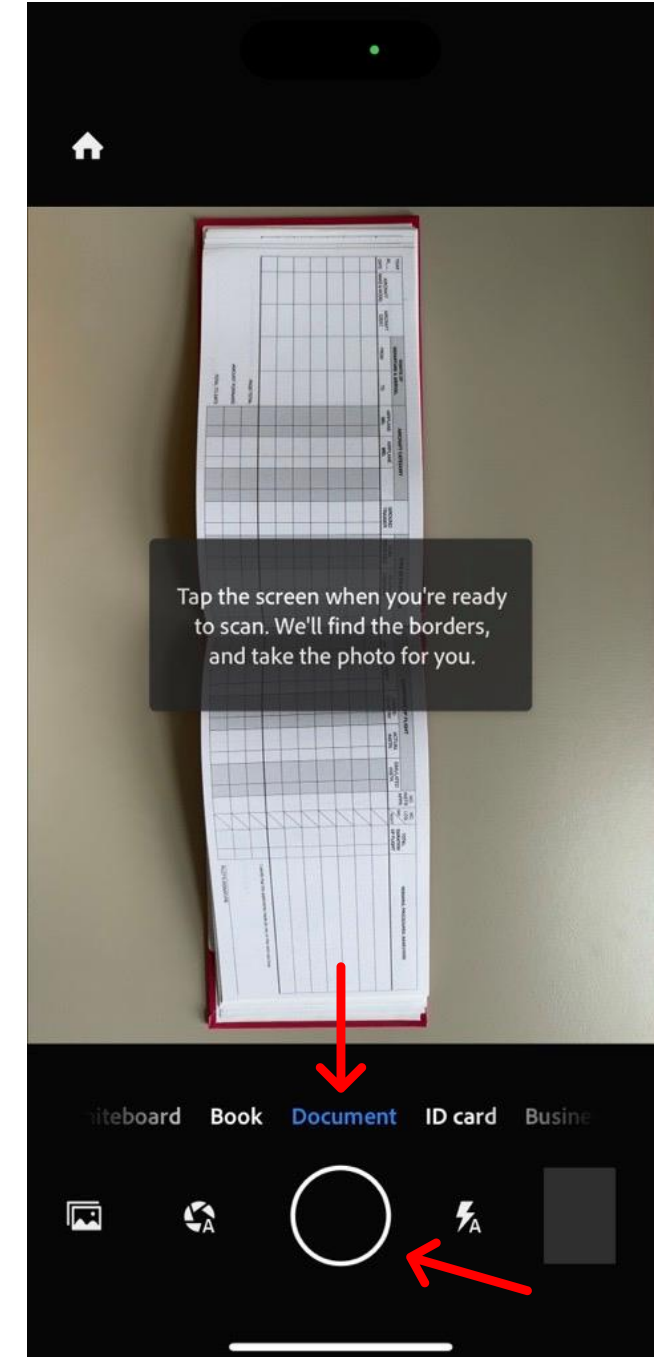
- *Please scan all pages of your logbook from the last two (2) calendar years*

After logging in:

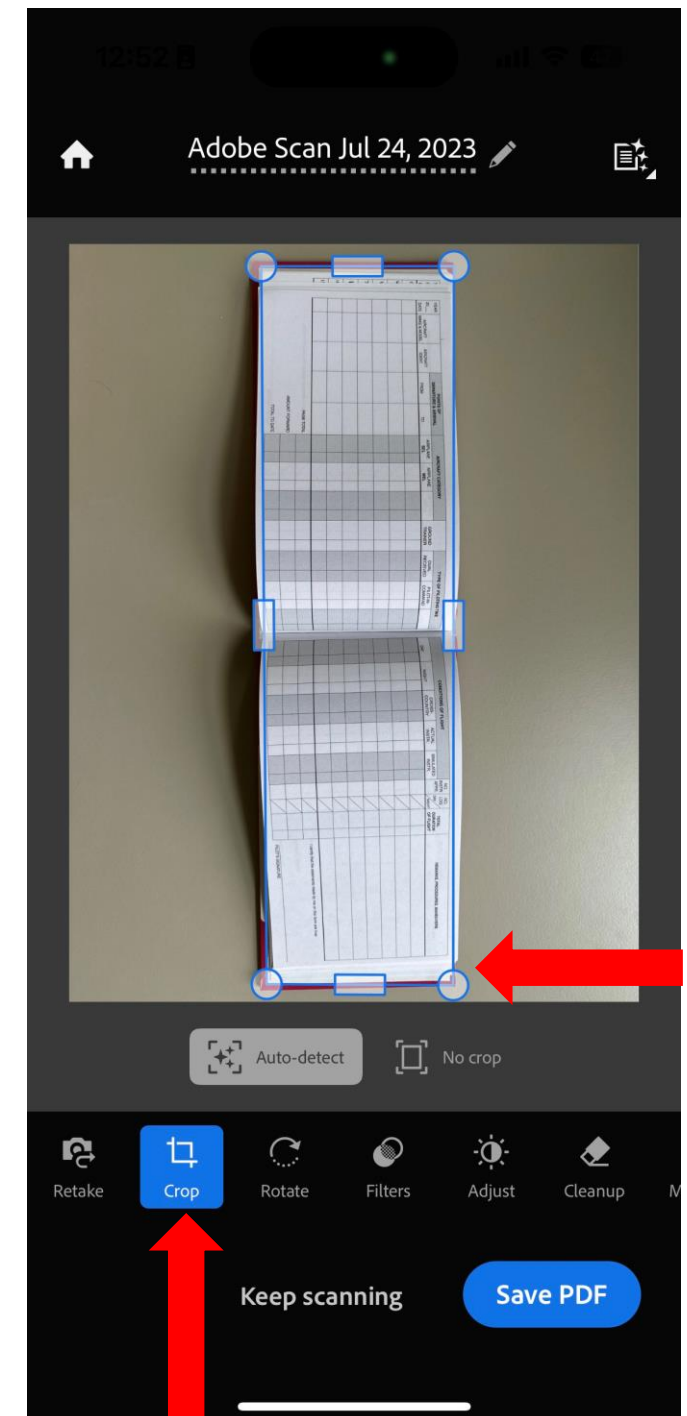
1. Make sure "Document" is selected at the bottom of the screen

How to Scan your Logbook

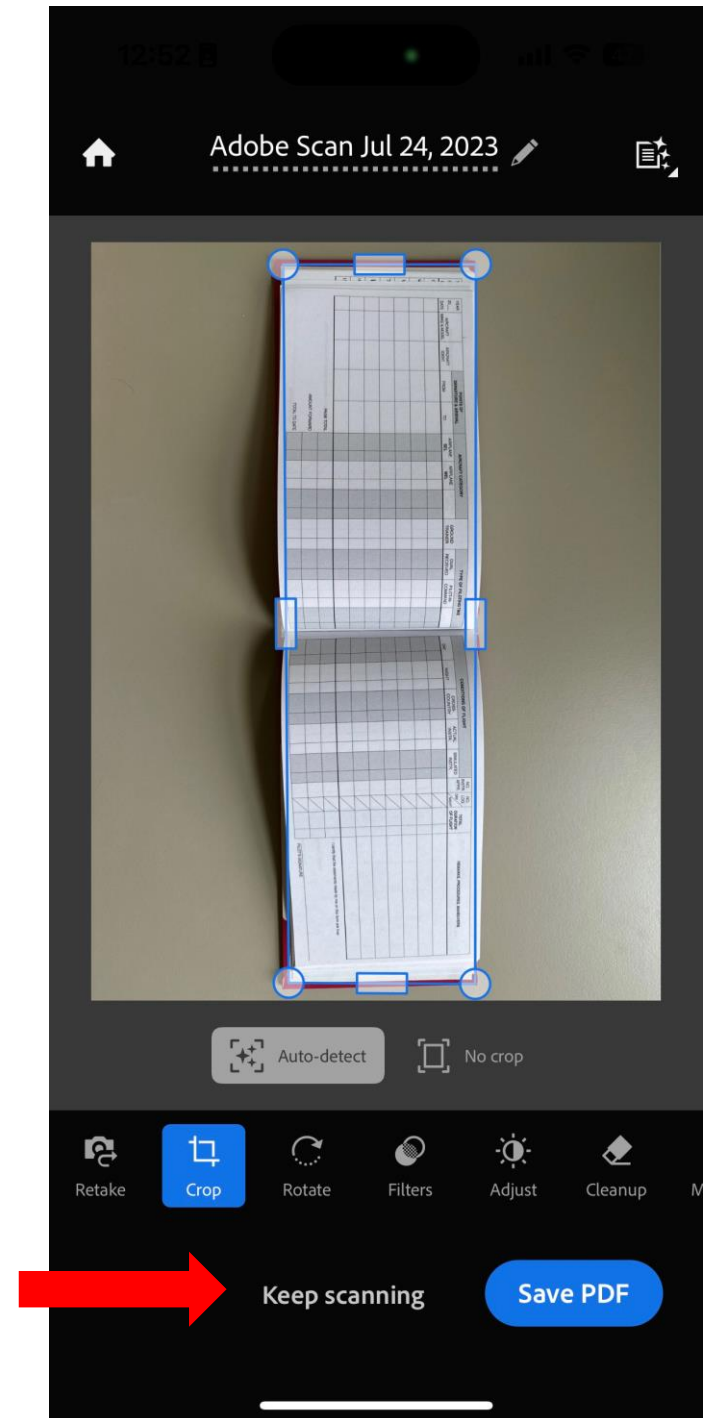
If needed, Drag the handles to adjust the borders.

2. Click Continue when you are satisfied with your photo



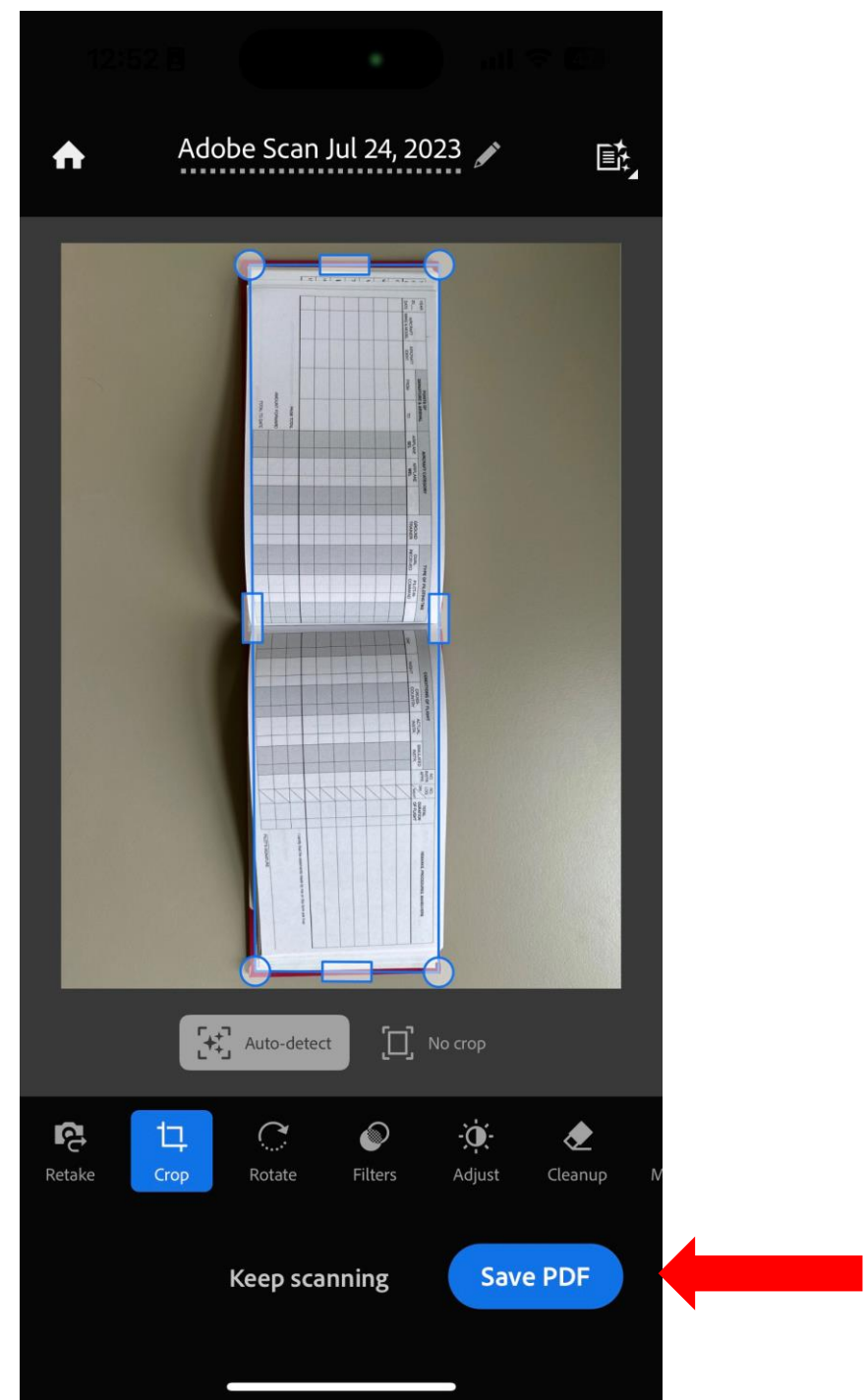

Repeat this step for each required page of your logbook.



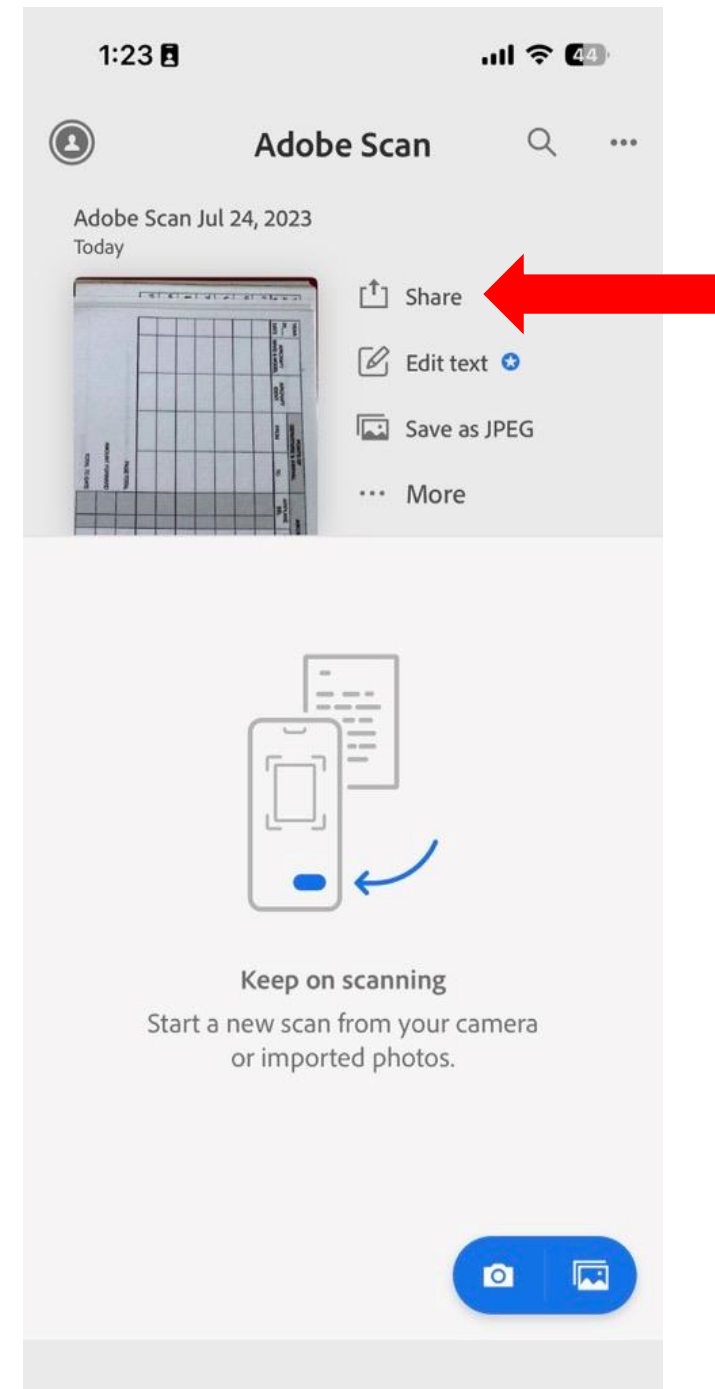

Once all required logbook pages are scanned, Save PDF



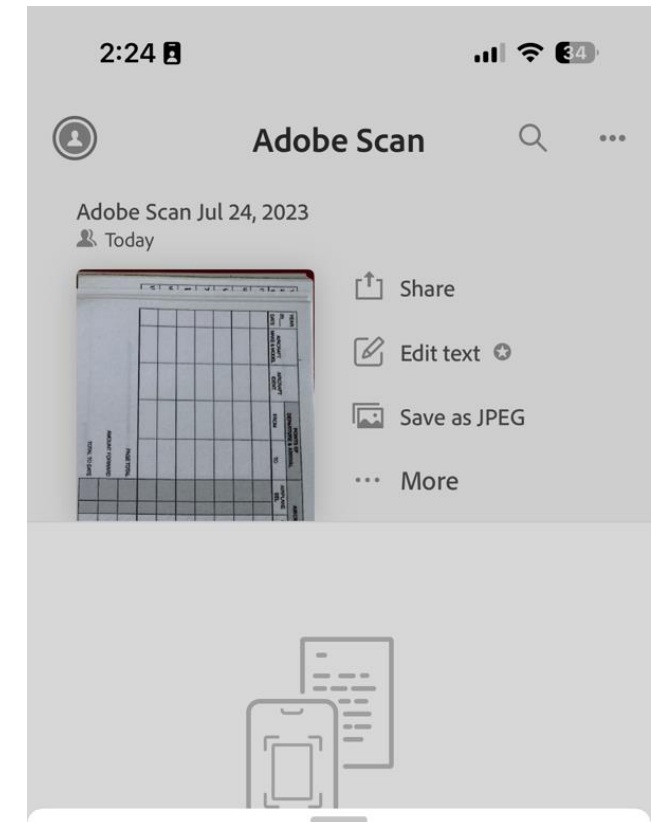
